


GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

This guideline has been prepared, first of all, for authors with little experience at the scientific conferences, but it can be helpful for authors who are experienced in giving lectures because it summarizes some useful information concerning the organizational questions, too. It is hoped that this leaflet will help to have uniformly high-level presentations at the CMIC2017.

1. Preparation of Posters



- Posters should be simple, brief and prepared having in minds, primarily, their use as a basis for the presentation and possible discussion of the work that is already published in the Congress Proceedings. However, they should be also self-intelligible.
- The poster should include an Abstract. The information may conveniently be divided into sections, starting with an Introduction and ending with Conclusion.
- As poster should be readable by more than one person at the same time, a letter size of at least 6 mm in height for the text and 10 mm for the section headings are suggested.

2. Poster Board Dimensions

- Poster numbers, placed in the left corner of the heading will be provided by the Secretariat.
- Each poster presentation must have a title including the title of the paper, author(s), affiliation(s), city and country. This part should be prepared by the presenting author to fit into the provided space (65 cm x 20 cm) or, if necessary, (65 cm x 25 cm)
- Each of the poster should contain a complete piece of information, such as the abstract, a figure of table with a simple legend, or a few entire paragraphs.
- Any necessary equipment for attaching the sheets to the board will be available near the poster location. Please use only the provided materials in order not to damage the panels and enable a smooth removal afterwards.

3. Other Remarks

- Please confirm the presentation times in the Final Programme of the Congress.
- An author is expected to be at the poster location during the presentation time assigned for the relevant poster session. This time will be specified in the Final Programme of the conference, together with the time assigned for putting up and taking down the posters.
- Please note there will be no session chairpersons for the poster discussions.
